

## CAC Meeting 2/13/2014

### Call to Order: Principal Baker

- Mr. Spear will be returning to classroom teaching from his year as specialist. He is looking forward to having a class of his own again. His position will change to a Bilingual Literacy Specialist funded by Title 1.

-Title one funds will decrease as the neighborhood continues to change. Fewer families are qualifying for free/reduced lunch which causes a reduction in Title 1 funding.

-Budget review and approval by CAC members.

-Mr Baker provided the CAC with copies of the district's proposed rating system for HB 5. All schools will be rated on Fine Arts, Wellness and Physical Education, Community and Parental Involvement, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce Development, Second Language Acquisition, Digital Learning Environment, Dropout Prevention Strategies, Gifted and Talented, and Compliance. Mr Baker stated that he did not feel the system was onerous. Most of the items are self reported by the principal. There could be changes to the system in coming years.

-Discussion of room parents. It was discussed how to improve communication and make the best use of position of room parent for next school year.

-Although there was discussion at previous meetings concerning changing Pre K arrival and pick-up time, the decision has been made that no changes to drop off and pick-up times will be made since there is no additional staff to assist with PK dismissal and late pickups.

-Mr. Spear raised safety concerns surrounding car pick-up and the possibility of allowing students to leave with persons who are not on the authorization form. Mr Spear will be creating new forms for the car line that are cross referenced with the office forms. Persons who are not on the form will have to wait until we can verify their authorization.

-There will be no March meeting. Meetings will resume in April
